Field Hand Internship

Join the farmers twice a month. Learn and get involved with the different aspects of running a CSA; seeding, transplanting, irrigation set up, growing the vegetables, harvesting, packing and overall regenerative practices. Opportunities are available for current students in the Agroecology program and through the USDA funded farmers outreach program for beginning and socially disadvantaged aspiring farmers. Experience the farm operations from the beginning to the end of a growing season. Start by contacting the farm manager. Begins in January 2024.

Research Opportunities

In addition to regular farm tasks and responsibilities, interns will have the opportunity to conduct a research project at the farm. This is a more independently driven project and can be decided on by the student and guided by the farm manager. Begins December 2023.
